Our water system violated State drinking water requirement. Even though these were not emergencies, you, as our customers, have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

An on-site evaluation of our system is conducted on a regular basis. Results of the evaluation show significant deficiencies in our water system which must be addressed to the Office of Environmental Health Services-District Office. We did not correct these deficiencies by the required date and are therefore in violation (V#2021-391008). We have 30 days to get Public Notice out. For unforeseen issues that happened the City did not get Public Notice out by the required date and are therefore in violation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.
